

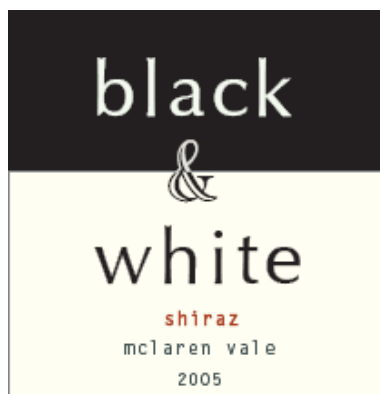

Black & White is a wine of no nonsense, no critters, no gimmicks. It is a pure, unadulterated, clean wine, that is rich, full-flavored, spicy, and perfectly balanced. This is a wine for all occasions – enjoy it everyday, or for those special occasions when a tuxedo and little black dress are called for.

Black & White



Wine

Fragrant blackberry, cedar, and vanilla aromas explode from within the dark, glass-coating purple liquid. Long palate of spice, saddle leather, and dark berries and firm yet very soft tannins. This wine is ready for drinking now, or over the next 3-4 years.

Vintage

2005 vintage – a warm year of good yields that produced fruit with a great balance of ripeness and acidity. A typically consistent and classy vintage in McLaren Vale.

Region

McLaren Vale is nestled in a triangle bounded by the foothills of the Mount Lofty Ranges to the south and east, and the calm waters of the Gulf of St Vincent to the west. Warm days and cool afternoon sea breezes create the perfect growing environment for old vine Shiraz – Australia's best known grape variety.

Vineyards

This 40-acre estate has mature vines dating back to the early 1950s. The fruit for this wine is blended from four vineyard parcels, or 'blocks', showing varied qualities that create a balanced yet complex wine. The blocks include 'Chalk Hill', 'Almond Grove', 'Old Flat' and 'Oliver Road', all of which have rich loam soils over limestone.

Winemaking

100% Shiraz harvested in late March 2005. Fermented in original 2 ton tanks with 'continual-submerge' arms that maintain the grape skins & solids in the fermenting juice for maximum flavor & color extraction. Aged in 300lt 'Hogsheads' combining a mix of new and 1 & 2 year old American (60%) and French (40%) oak barrels.
